

Launched in 1999 by Emmy award-winning Milwaukee journalist Melodie Wilson Oldenburg ABCD: After Breast Cancer Diagnosis nurtures hope and restores confidence in all those affected by breast cancer, from the newly diagnosed to those in treatment and beyond. We understand that breast cancer is so much more than appointments, biopsies, surgeries and treatments. It is about the whole person and requires support from people who know what it is really like after a breast cancer diagnosis.

Our signature service is matching breast cancer patients, families and friends (Participants) who need emotional support with professionally trained volunteer breast cancer survivors (Mentors). These highly customized matches connect people with the same diagnosis and treatment plan who also have common interests, personal traits, and family dynamics. Mentors provide hope, compassion, understanding and empathy when people need it the most. All services are FREE and can be conducted over the phone or via email, in English or Spanish.



Melodie's founding vision was clear: No one needs to feel alone after hearing the words "you have breast cancer." Today, support like ABCD's is recognized by the National Cancer Institute as integral to survivorship care.

2018: A transformational year for ABCD

ABCD SUPPORTS TWICE AS MANY PEOPLE NATIONWIDE IN 2018 Earns \$250,000 in the first year of Keith Mardak's matching donation challenge

Dear friends.

On behalf of our Mentors, Participants, Volunteers, Board of Directors, and Staff, thank you for supporting ABCD: After Breast Cancer Diagnosis.

Without a doubt, 2018 was a year of tremendous growth allowing us to reach these milestones:

- Served more people in Wisconsin and around the country
- Deepened partnerships with healthcare organizations
- · Launched new outreach and awareness campaigns with community and corporate partners
- Overhauled technology software to better serve Participants and donors

Most notably in January 2018, we launched the Mardak 2020 Breast Cancer Initiative, a comprehensive outreach program focused on increasing services and building our donor base. This special initiative is the cornerstone of a \$2 million, four-year challenge grant presented to ABCD by Keith Mardak and Mary Vandenberg, long-time donors and friends of our organization. To ensure receipt of the full match, ABCD needed to meet performance metrics, including raising an additional \$250,000 by the end of 2018, to be considered for additional funding in 2019.

Thanks to the generosity of many ongoing and new individual donors, corporate sponsors, community partners and foundations, ABCD met the Mardak 2020 Challenge for Year One! In fact, we raised more funds in 2018 than ever before, ending the year with a surplus. More importantly, we supported more than 5,000 people in 2018, compared to an estimated 2,500 in 2017, and experienced a 29% increase in matches in 2018 compared to 2017.

Our vision is that every woman or man who is diagnosed or living with breast cancer knows about ABCD and has access to our critical services. No one else - not a helpline, a website, or even a medical professional - provides the personalized connection that we do at ABCD.




